GENERAL CAT CARE

8. Keep crates, carriers, and bedding clean		
9. My cat has been spayed or neutered

At the end of your essay, include a bibliography of book, websites or people that were interviewed. The bibliography will not be included in your word count. You must use your own words, no plagiarizing will be allowed, just as with school papers.
