- First year notebook using study sheets including 12 leaves.
- Second year notebook using study sheets with additional 12 leaves (24 leaves total).
- Third year and above notebook using study sheets with 12 additional leaves for each year. Project is to include a poster or 3D exhibit depicting some principles or facts about native Michigan trees.
