## Photography Guidelines

## Age Groups:

Beginner: Ages 7-11
Junior: Ages 12-15
Senior: 16-19

## Notes:

- Only one exhibit per section.
- If your exhibit is going to be on a mounting board, it should be 20 inches horizontal and 16 inches vertical.
- Whether your exhibit is on a mounting board or in a frame, it is required to have a sturdy, commercial type hanger attached firmly to the back.
- No taped string, paper clip, etc. type "hanger".
- Frames with glass are not allowed.
- Plexiglass, acrylic or like material is allowed.
- Any picture previously exhibited is not allowed.
- Exhibitor must take all pictures in display.
- Photographs must have been taken since prior year's fair.
- Maximum size of the photograph should be $8 \times 10^{\prime \prime}$, not including the mounting or the frame.
- Exception: If photo is a collage, a larger print is acceptable as long as it does not exceed the $20^{\prime \prime}$ horizontal by $16^{\prime \prime}$ vertical rule.
- Photos taken from a cell phone are acceptable.
- Make sure your exhibit is crisp and clear.
- Understand the type of camera you used, shutter speed, filter, etc.
- Understand the rule of thirds for taking a picture.
- Be able to explain any special effects used.
